



CANCER SCREENING

FOR TRANS AND NON-BINARY PATIENTS

BOWEL SCREENING

Everyone aged 60-74 will be invited to complete a bowel screening kit. It is a simple test that can be completed in your home in just a few minutes. Tell your doctor if you are a trans woman and have had genital reconstruction surgery using a loop of bowel.



CERVICAL SCREENING

Anyone with a cervix aged 21 to 64 will be invited. This includes the following people providing they have not had an operation to remove their womb and cervix:

- trans men
- people who are non-binary but assigned female at birth
- cis-gender women

Advice for trans men and non-binary people assigned female at birth:

- if you are registered as a female with your GP you will automatically be enrolled for screening unless you have opted out
- If you are registered as male with your GP you will not be automatically invited for cervical screening but you can get an appointment by contacting your GP

BREAST SCREENING

Anyone between 50 and 70 who has breasts due to either naturally occurring oestrogen or oestrogen hormone therapy is eligible for screening.
